Wolkenhain Viewing Platform on Kienberg

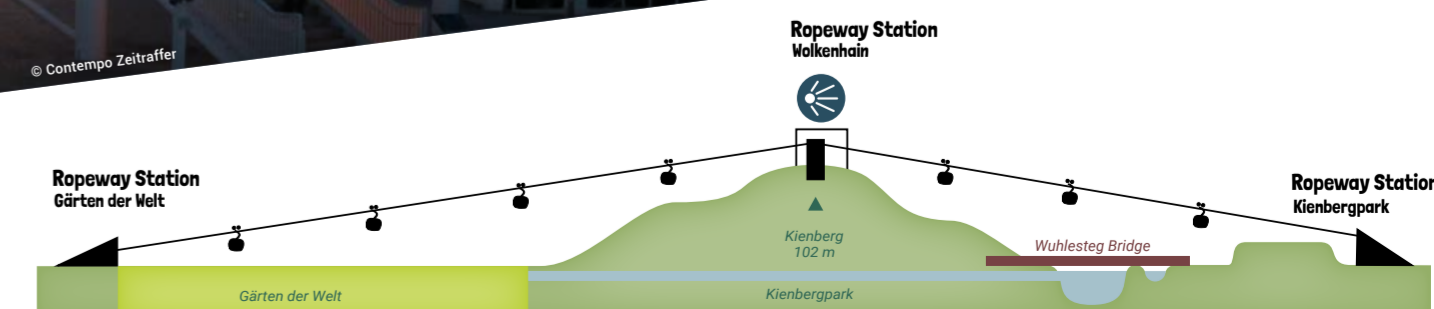


1.5 kilometers total length of the ropeway system

With a day combination ticket, you can make use of the entire premises, including Gärten der Welt and Kienbergpark and you can also use the Ropeway.

After a trip up Kienberg or a ride on the Ropeway, you can only get back into Gärten der Welt with a day combination ticket!

The day combination ticket grants you entry into Gärten der Welt a maximum of twice on one day.
